

Amendments submitted by the Left in the European Parliament:

Stresses that everything must be done to bring Russia back to the negotiating table; recalls that the OSCE, as a regional arrangement under Chapter VIII of the UN Charter, remains the organisation of first resort for the peaceful settlement of disputes in the region; calls for the use of UN crisis resolution mechanisms; calls for the EU, its Member States and the United States to continue their diplomatic efforts to bring the war in Ukraine to an end;

Calls for an immediate and unconditional ceasefire; demands that channels of communication with Russia remain open and that the parties concerned be prepared for dialogue and negotiations until a ceasefire is in force and the war ended;

underlines that the sanctions might have a specific impact on European households and that they should not pay the price of this crisis; calls therefore on the Member States to prepare plans and subsidies for households to avoid the deepening of the energy crisis

Calls for the EU and the Member States to support the anti-war movements protesting against Putin's invasion of Ukraine in Russia and in Belarus

Is extremely concerned about the alliance between far-right parties represented in the European Parliament and the Russian ruling party and about their impact on our democracies, as well as the foreign and covert funding of parties, individuals and movements aimed at social fragmentation and the destabilisation of the EU
